### INSTRUCTIONS:

You will use the same passage that you have used for Homework Assignments 1-4.

1. LOOK at the publication information on the opening pages of your textbook and at the page where you originally got your passage in the anthology;
2. RECORD the information that you will need to construct a proper Works Cited entry for the text from which you took your passage:
  - Text author;
  - Text translator (where applicable);
  - Text full title;
  - page numbers (inclusive);
  - Anthology title (including any subtitles);
  - Anthology editors;

- Publisher's full name;
  - Place of Publication;
  - Date of publication.
3. ARRANGE the information in proper MLA works cited format as demonstrated in class.
  4. TYPE the information on a clean sheet with the title "Works Cited" at the top of the page.

**YOU WILL HAND IN:**

- Your PHOTOCOPY/TRANSCRIPTION with the mark-up and the question, the question answer, and your INTEGRATED QUOTATION on the same page;
- Your WORKS CITED page, TYPED in Times New Roman, 12-pt font.
